Legal basis of the processing operation:

- Art. 6 paragraph 1 lit. f GDPR („legitimate interest“)
- § 4 Federal Data Protection Act

Purpose of the processing operation:

- Protection of domiciliary right
- Legitimate interests, especially:
 - clarification of burglary, theft, and property damage
 - attack & personal protection
 - preservation of evidence
 - access control

Which recipients the data may be disclosed to?

Generally, your data are not disclosed to any third party, if no protective purpose occurred. In case of occurrence, however, the data may be disclosed to investigating internal persons or investigating authorities to clarify matters.

How long will the data be stored?

Generally, the records are stored for as long as 72 hours maximum and automatically deleted afterwards. In case of a protective purpose, the relevant information is stored until clarification or until the end of legal deadlines and deleted afterwards manually.

Your rights – Rights of the data according to GDPR:

Art. 12 – 23 GDPR define the rights of the data subject, i.e. your rights concerning the handling of your personal data. With respect to us these are mainly:

- Right of access by the data subject according to Art. 15 GDPR
- Right to rectification according to Art. 16 GDPR
- Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) according to Art. 17 GDPR
- Right to restriction of processing according to Art. 18 GDPR
- If applicable: Right to data portability according to Art. 20 GDPR
- Right to object according to Art. 21 GDPR
- Right to complain according to Art. 13, paragraph 2 lit. d GDPR:
